

YOLA provides *transformational and equitable access to music education* for young people from historically marginalized communities, to support their personal development, their communities, and beyond.

YOLA = Access

- **1575** Local Students
- **100+** Local Teachers
- **12-18** Hours Onsite Weekly:
incl. orchestra/group rehearsals, private lessons, homework time & assistance, free reading, snack
- **14** Orchestras
- **30+** Performances Annually
- College Counseling & Social Services





YOLA Family Annual Income






YOLA Musician Experience

- **Year 1-2:** Enroll in a local program hub
 - > *Receive 12-15 hours/week of group instruction and ensemble rehearsals*
- **Year 2-4:** Start private lessons participate in additional YOLA programs
 - > *YOLA Institute, YOLA Camp, Summer Music festivals*
- **Year 4-6:** Audition into competitive programs
 - > *YOLA National Festival*
- **Year 6+:** Consider your musical future or other pathways/participate in special opportunities
 - > *YOLA tour, performances at Hollywood Bowl and Walt Disney Concert Hall*


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

Budget & Operations Considerations

Funding from contributed revenue

- YOLA at Inglewood program costs
- BYC facility operations costs

Functioning as a school environment

- Security & operations
- Student & family engagement



Considerations for Advisory

- No single model for a cultural center. The right approach depends on clearly defined roles **for civic and nonprofit partners.**
- Invest in looking at peers like LA Plaza, The Music Center as helpful examples for ***governance/structure/funding*** – since Cultural Center envisioned as Multi Program, Multi Building project – to think through cohesion.
- Values must guide the work. Balancing access, support for artists, and operational stability is essential.
- Center the SELA Cultural as an education space for families and young people at the core – the root of community.
